We've got suggestions on venues and extra games as well as ways to maximise your fundraising success. Our top tip though is to rope in as many people as possible to help you – it's much more fun to organise things together! You've signed up, downloaded your Swot Up quiz night pack but what next?



CHOOSE A VENUE

Traditionally quiz nights are held in pubs, and that's always a great place to start; they're comfortable with all the facilities you might need and the landlords are usually happy to get bums on seats and orders at the bar. However, you don't have to go down the traditional route; your Swot Up Quiz Night can be anywhere you choose – a social club, a workplace, a classroom...in the summer months you could even host outdoors and provide a barbeque. The skies the limit!



SET A DATE

Settle on a date that works best for you and your chosen venue and get it in the diary. Text or email everyone you want to invite and set up a Facebook event page. Finally, print off some copies of the Big Quiz Night poster and plaster them wherever you can. Make sure the venue displays as many as possible.



ADD IN SOME EXTRAS

Plan to boost your fundraising on the might with some little extras;

- hold a raffle on the night, try and aim for one or two really good prizes rather than lots of little ones (i.e. Tablet or phone). Then you can charge more per ticket!
- 2 talk to the venue about providing food and ask quiz teams for a donation
- 3 play stand-up bingo or Sticky 13 between rounds for £1 ago



QUIZ NIGHT

Make sure to arrive early to make sure the venue is all set up. We have included some printable bunting and by now you should have received your balloons and collection box. You'll need to print off everything we sent you so don't forget your score sheets, answer sheets and most importantly the questions and answers!

OTHER LAST MINUTE TIPS

- Arrive in plenty of time; not only do you want the room to look amazing but you'll need to make sure the microphone, speakers and any other equipment is working perfectly ahead of your big night.
- 2 Gather as much help as possible! Have a friend on hand to help with scores, collection boxes, etc. Also ask them to get as many photos as possible of your big night!
